



MAP IS DISAPPOINTED WITH PAS FOR FALLING SQUARELY INTO POLITICAL TRAP DESIGNED BY MYSTEROUS HANDS.

MAP expresses deep disappointment that PAS has fallen squarely into a political trap set by mysterious hands, a trap designed not to uphold the rule of law, but to **manufacture artificial religious tension** as a calculated diversion from serious and growing questions now confronting national leadership under PMX.

The issue of Hindu temples is **not new**, nor is it a challenge to Malay or Muslim rights or the rule of law. It is a long-standing historical matter that traces back to **pre and post-independence failure of policies**, and more acutely to the **1980s**, when over **800,000 Indian plantation workers were forcibly displaced** from estates. Temples that had existed for up to 200 years on estate land were demolished in their thousands, and many are still in the same predicament. More so after the government acquired large chunks of plantation land, converted them for development, and made matters worse when it was sold to private developers. The existence of Hindu temples in these land was not recognised, even though they predate independence. **The truth of this legal complication is never explained by the government, which has fuelled mistrust, misunderstanding, and unwarranted contempt toward the Indian community.**

The mysterious, sudden and orchestrated attempt to label Hindu temples as symbols of land usurpation, illegality, or disrespect toward Malays is deliberate and has a larger political agenda.

This narrative is being amplified to **stoke unfounded fear among Malay Muslims**, a fear carefully engineered to serve **political survival and distraction**, not justice, truth, or national unity.

PAS, regrettably, has been manoeuvred by mysterious hands into endorsing a narrative that **creates religious suspicion**, placing the party in a disadvantaged position. This has already resulted in the **loss of Indian support** and has created the perception—fair or not—that PAS is aligned with religious hostility rather than justice.

This episode is nothing more than a calculated move by those aligned with PMX to **divert the attention of the rakyat from his mounting leadership failures**, including the following serious and unresolved matters:

i) The signing of an agreement with Trump was carried out **unconstitutionally**, a failure so grave that it has now been **challenged in court by five Members of Parliament** acting in defence of constitutional integrity;

ii) The Trump Anwar Agreement is widely perceived to have compromised national sovereignty, diminished the constitutional role of His Majesty the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, the Malay Rulers, and Parliament, and in doing so, placed the sovereignty of the nation into question—prompting growing public opposition by the day;

iii) His own appointment as Prime Minister is increasingly being questioned, with constitutional challenges emerging over his appointment as PM while being disqualified for committing sexual offence and sentenced to prison, without free pardon under Article 48 as well as allegations that the previous Agong was misled regarding his fitness to hold the office, now coming into the open.

iv) Allegations concerning his involvement in the framing of Yusuf Rawther in a fake firearm and drug case further to his sexual assault allegation have entered the public domain, exerting significant pressure on Anwar Ibrahim's moral authority and leadership;

v) The allegations involving land cession to Indonesia, coupled with a reluctance to openly debate the matter in Parliament, raise serious concerns and suggest that material facts are being withheld from the rakyat.

vi) The latest allegation linking PMX to the expose of DOJ files relating to Epstein indicating interference in Malaysia's general election by mysterious hands to exploit Anwar Ibrahim's position should he become PM

The **Indian community has suffered a profound loss of trust** in PMX—so much so that they are now prepared to give **PN, and by extension PAS, a genuine opportunity**, particularly with MAP fully backing PN and actively galvanising Indian voters ahead of the next General Election.

It is politically expedient for those linked to PMX to **frustrate Indian community** support for PN.

Creating religious anxiety is a **classic political tactic**. It is an old trick—used repeatedly across the world—where leaders under pressure redirect public anger toward issues or institutions.

MAP calls on PAS to reassess its position with wisdom and courage, and calls our Malay Muslim brothers and sisters to reject narratives built on half-truth and fear rather than facts.
